Scottish ballads constituted much of the material chosen by the English collector Thomas Percy for his Reliques of Ancient English Poetry (1765), one of the most influential publications of the eighteenth century. Percy was drawn to the ballads' poetic qualities, and he deemed them to be remnants of an ancient British poetry written by a formerly distinguished class, the minstrels.
