Extract the contents of the WordPress zip file, and note where you saved these files. Once the files are extracted, you'll need to create a wp-config.php file with your database information. To do this, open the WordPress folder, find the wp-config-sample.php file and open it in your favorite web editor or a text editor such as Notepad.
